



2013 Napa Valley Rosé

Our rose is a delightful by-product of Cabernet Sauvignon production. The technique, known as "saignier" (to bleed) involves removing a portion of juice from freshly crushed Cabernet Sauvignon grapes in order to concentrate the intensity of the resulting wine. The best of this saignier juice is retained to make this wonderful rosé wine.

Tasting Notes:

The Silenus 2013 Rosé is light ruby, like the color of a summer sunset at its peak. The wine displays fresh fruity aromas of cherry, strawberry and watermelon. It has a wonderfully rich mouth-feel with flavors of cherries and honeydew melon. With just a touch of sweetness, it is a delightfully rich, but refreshing wine.
